




NDA RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

The Drug Authority is committed to implementing a risk management system, encompassing both external and internal issues, that creates and protects the value of NDA by minimising uncertainty in achieving its objectives, taking advantage of opportunities and improving performances.

Risk management is an integral part of NDA's governance and risk-based thinking in accordance with ISO 9001:2015. NDA has integrated risk management into all its core drug regulatory and support processes, and decision making.

The Drug Authority has therefore established roles, responsibilities, authorities and accountabilities for risk management in accordance with ISO 31000:2018 and has provided the necessary resources to enable the measurement, reporting and review of risks geared to preventing negative effects.

To meet this commitment, all employees are required to be competent and accountable for managing risks within their area of responsibility.

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
