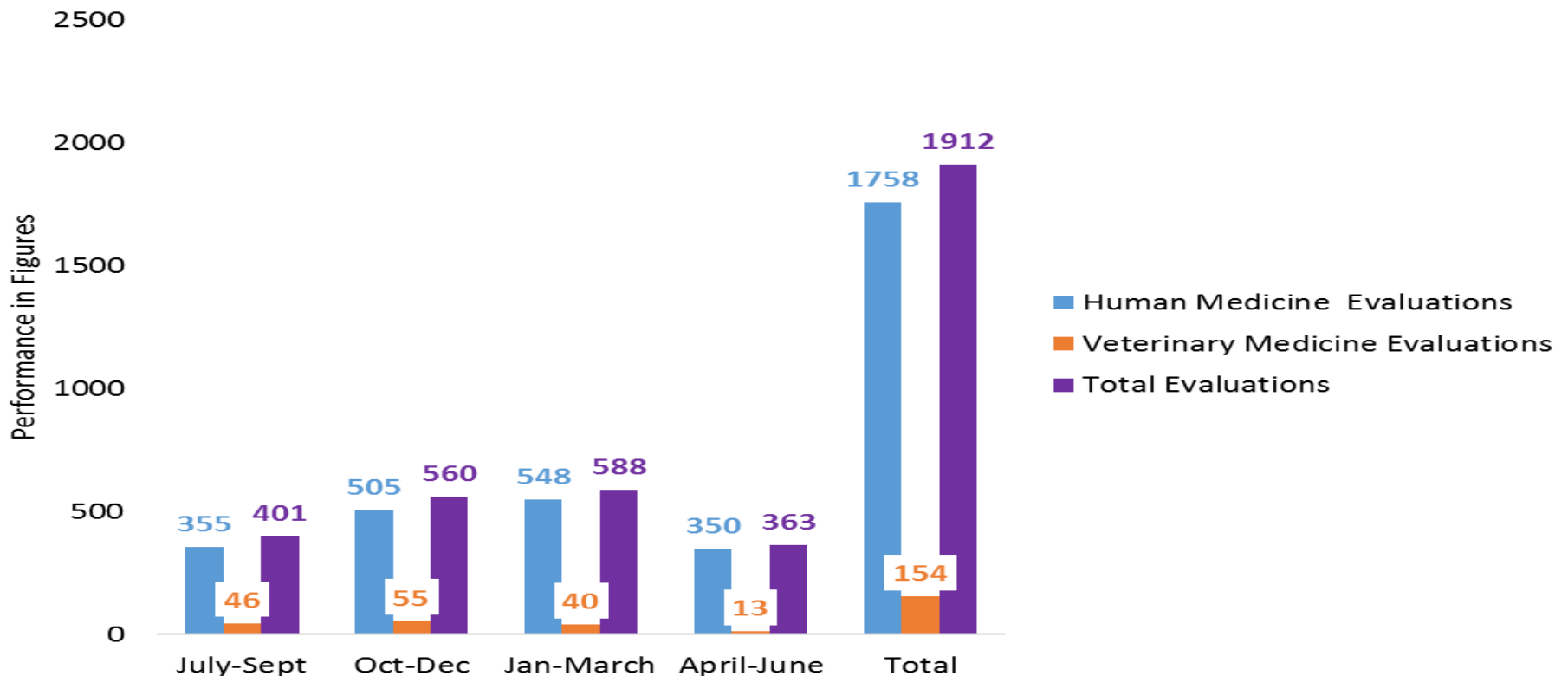

The National Drug Authority (NDA) was established to ensure availability of safe, efficacious and quality medicines (VETERINARY AND HUMAN) to the entire population of Uganda.

In the financial year 2018/19, NDA was able to evaluate all **154 VETERINARY** medicine products received.

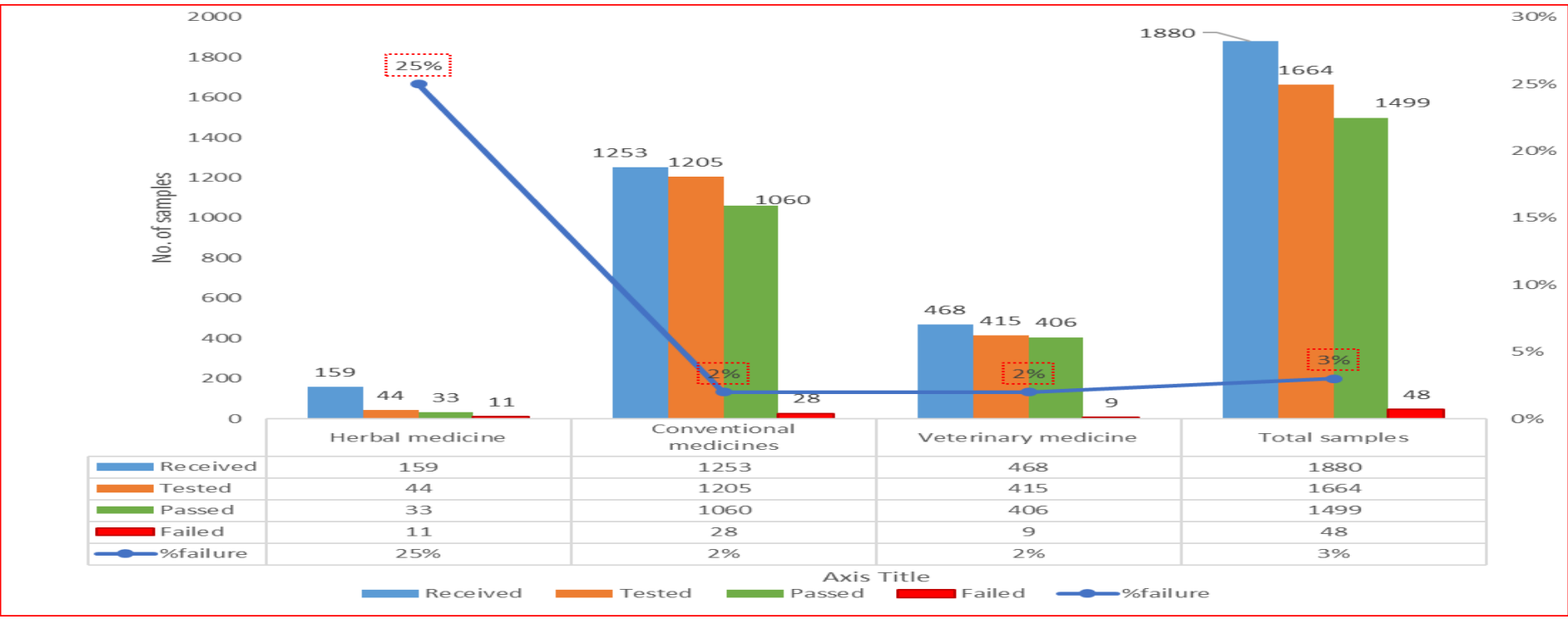

DID YOU KNOW?

NDA improved and increased its Quality Control Laboratory to test a range of medicines (human, **VETERINARY**, conventional and herbals). The Laboratory tested 2,391 out of the 2,630 samples received.



Overall failure rate for Medicines passing the quality tests is 3% (48 out of 1664 medicine samples that were tested). Herbal Medicines have the highest failure rate of 25% (11 out of 44 samples that were tested) followed by Conventional Human Medicines with a failure rate of 2% (28 out of 1205 samples that were tested) and **VETERINARY** Medicines having the least failure rate of 2% (9 out of 415 samples that were tested).

DID YOU KNOW?

As a custodian of ensuring guaranteed animal health, production, and domestic income NDA has implemented the following:

- Registering **VETERINARY** medicines for use in the country
- Licensing **VETERINARY** medicines manufacturing sites
- **VETERINARY** drug outlets (Pharmacies and drug shops)
- Authorizing **VETERINARY** medicine imports at ports of entry.
- Quality control through **VETERINARY** medicines assessment for proper active ingredients.

For guaranteed animal health and production NDA has always advised the public on good veterinary medicine use and practice.

- Buying drugs from NDA Licensed veterinary drug outlets.
- Seeking veterinarian advice before buying drugs for treating your animals.
- Reading label instruction regarding dosage, how, when to administer and for how long, and storage conditions.
- Checking for the manufacturer name, country of origin , manufacturer and expiry dates and batch numbers.
- Keep medicines out of reach of children
